"There is some disappointment in Pope Francis [among progressives"> now because they want him to act quickly, they want him to change laws, they want him to be different," said Christian Weisner, a founding member of a Munich-based Catholic reform group who advocates church-sanctioned samesex unions.

"What I see here is that he is starting a process, one that will redefine the moral teachings of the Roman Catholic Church," he said. "But that's going to take a long time, and some people are disappointed because of that."
